# Post-Matric Scholarship to SBC Students, Maharashtra



- ▶ The candidates must belong to the SBC category and must have permanent residence or a domicile certificate of Maharashtra.
- ▶ The family income should not exceed INR 1,00,000 per annum.
- ▶ The government should approve the courses pursued by the students.
- ▶ Only two male children in the family can apply. However, any number of girl children in the family can apply for the scholarship.
- ▶ The students should have at least 75% of attendance.
- ▶ The students cannot change their courses in the middle of the academic year.

# Documents & Benefits

- ▶ **1. Caste certificate** - should be issued by competent authority (Issued by Govt. of Maharashtra) This certificate considered as Proof of Resident.
- ▶ **2. Income certificate / Income Declaration** - should be issued by competent authority
- ▶ **3. Caste Validity Certificate** - (Mandatory for Professional Degree courses, Professional Post Graduate. For Non Professional courses caste validity is not mandatory)
- ▶ **4. HSC or SSC marksheet or last examination marksheet.**
- ▶ **5. Gap certificate** - Not mandatory but in case of gap it is mandatory.
- ▶ **6. If applicable father/Guardians death certificate.**
- ▶ **7. Ration Card** for identify number of children in family.
- ▶ **8. Leaving Certificate**
- ▶ **9. Declaration certificate of parents/guardians** about number of children beneficiaries.
  
- ▶ **Scholarship amount ranging from INR 150 to INR 425** per month offered to hostellers.
  
- ▶ **Scholarship amount ranging from INR 90 to INR 190** per month granted to the day-scholars
  
- ▶ **Full Tuition Fees and Examination Fees Scholarship to OBC Students**



# Tuition Fees and Examination Fees to OBC Students

- ▶ The OBC students residing in Maharashtra and studying post matriculation level can avail the benefits of this scholarship.
- ▶ Family income should not exceed INR 8,00,000 per annum.
- ▶ Candidates should belong to the OBC category.
- ▶ The government should approve the courses pursued by the students.
- ▶ Students should study in government, government-aided, or private non-aided institutions.
- ▶ Students pursuing a degree in Medical, Dental, Homeopathy, Unani, Ayurveda, Physiotherapy, Business Aid, and Nursing are eligible for the freeship.
- ▶ Students pursuing diploma, undergraduate, and postgraduate courses in Engineering, Pharmacology, HMCT, MBA/MMS, and MCA will be eligible for freeship.
- ▶ The government will cover the tuition and exam fees for the students pursuing D.Ed and B.Ed courses.
- ▶ Admission should be through CAP round for the students pursuing professional courses.
- ▶ The candidates cannot enjoy the benefits of the scholarships for more than two times.

- ▶ Reimbursement of **tuition fee and exam fees**
  - ▶ The government will reimburse students' **full cost of fees** pursuing professional courses in government or government-aided institutions.
  - ▶ The government will refund **50% of the tuition and exam fees** for students pursuing professional studies in private unaided institutions.

# Government Vidyaniketan Scholarship



- ▶ The Maharashtra scholarship form is available on the Maharashtra scholarship portal.
- ▶ Students should have secured a minimum of 60% marks in the Class X examination.
- ▶ Students should have cleared class X from the state government vidyanikethan
- ▶ The students should have permanent residence or domicile of Maharashtra.

# Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Vasatigrub Nirvah Bhatta Yojna



- ▶ The candidates should have Indian nationality and should be domiciles of Maharashtra.
- ▶ The candidates should be full-time students enrolled in a technical college operated by the state pursuing diploma, graduate, or postgraduate courses.
- ▶ Private universities and deemed universities are not accepted.
- ▶ Admission of the students should be through the Centralized Admission Process (CAP)
- ▶ The scheme is limited to only two children in a family.
- ▶ Family income should not exceed INR 8,00,000 per annum.
- ▶ The candidates should have at least 50% attendance in the previous semester.
- ▶ The government will discontinue the scheme if the candidate has a gap of two or more than two years.

- ▶ If the child of the registered labour or alpabudharak (marginal landholder) is -
  - ▶ Studying in an institute located in MMRDA, PMRDA, Aurangabad city, or Nagpur city will receive **INR 30,000** for ten months.
  - ▶ Studying in an institute outside MMRDA, PMRDA, Aurangabad city, or Nagpur city will receive **INR 20,000** for ten months.
  - ▶ If the family income is up to INR 8,00,000 per annum -
  - ▶ Candidates studying in an institute located in MMRDA, PMRDA, Aurangabad city, or Nagpur city will receive **INR 10,000** for ten months.
  - ▶ Candidates pursuing a course in an institute outside the MMRDA, PMRDA, Aurangabad city, or Nagpur city region will receive **INR 8,000** for ten months.

- ▶ The students should be domiciles of Maharashtra.
- ▶ Students should reside in Maharashtra.
- ▶ Students should be studying at JNU.
- ▶ Students should be pursuing an undergraduate or postgraduate course

# Eklavya Scholarship

- ▶ The candidates should be a permanent resident or domiciled in Maharashtra.
- ▶ Students should be pursuing postgraduate courses.
- ▶ The arts and commerce students must have secured 60% marks in their graduation.
- ▶ The science students must have secured 70% marks in their graduation.
- ▶ Parental annual income should not exceed Rs.75.000
- ▶ Students should not have a full-time or a part-time job at the time of application.

- ▶ Family income should not exceed INR 8,00,000 per annum.
- ▶ This scholarship is limited to only two children in a family.
- ▶ Students should have at least 50% attendance in the previous semester.
- ▶ The department will discontinue the scholarship if the student has a gap of more than two years.

# Post-Matric Tuition Fee and Examination Fee (Freeship) Scholarship

- ▶ The scholarship is exclusively for students from the scheduled caste or neo bouddhist community.
- ▶ Family income should not exceed INR 2,50,000 per annum.
- ▶ Students should be a permanent resident of Maharashtra.
- ▶ Students should have cleared the SSC or equivalent examination.
- ▶ Students should be studying in an institution recognized by the state government.
- ▶ Not applicable to students studying outside Maharashtra
- ▶ The admission of the students pursuing professional studies should be through CAP.
- ▶ Students can fail only once in the whole curriculum.

- ▶ Candidates should have secured at least 60% marks in the SSC examination.
- ▶ Candidates should have cleared the SSC exam in their first attempt.
- ▶ Candidates should have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the first year of the junior college beneficiary category.

  - ▶ 5. Maharashtrian Students studying Out of Maharashtra cannot apply for this scheme.
