## **Cleanliness Drive by AICUF Forum of St. Vincent College at Slum of Gultekadi near Market Yard Pune**

### **Introduction:**

On the 10<sup>th</sup> October 2022, the All India Catholic University Federation (AICUF) Forum of St. Vincent College organized a cleanliness drive in the slum area of Gultekadi near Market Yard Pune. In this cleanliness drive, 28 students were actively participated. The initiative aimed to promote cleanliness, hygiene, and community welfare in an underprivileged urban neighbourhood.

### **Objective:**

The primary objective of the cleanliness drive was to raise awareness about the importance of cleanliness and sanitation among the residents of the slum area. ### **Activities:**

**Post-Clean-Up Evaluation:** Following the completion of the cleanliness drive, a post-clean-up evaluation was conducted to assess the impact of the initiative. Feedback was collected from both participants and residents to identify areas of improvement and plan future initiatives.

**Conclusion:**

The cleanliness drive organized by the AICUF Forum of St. Vincent College at the slum area of Gultekadi near Market Yard Pune was a commendable effort towards promoting community cleanliness and hygiene.
