## A short narration of the program

On 17th February 2025, St. Vincent College, Pune, in collaboration with the Sambhav Foundation, successfully organized a Job Fair on campus with the objective of providing meaningful employment opportunities to students and job seekers across a wide range of professional domains. The event saw an overwhelming response from final-year students, recent graduates, and alumni who participated in large numbers to explore career opportunities in both technical and non-technical fields.

The registration process commenced at 10:00 AM, where participants were guided by student volunteers to complete the necessary formalities. The fair officially began at 11:00 AM and continued until 4:00 PM, witnessing a continuous flow of enthusiastic candidates interacting with company representatives, submitting resumes, and appearing for preliminary interviews. More than 20 employers and recruiters participated in the job fair, representing sectors such as Accounting, Finance, Data Science, Data Analysis, Store Management, IT Support, Back Office Operations, Banking, BPO, Sales, Marketing, and Field Jobs.

Dedicated stalls were set up by each participating company, and trained recruiters provided an overview of the job roles, expected skill sets, and growth opportunities. The companies conducted on-the-spot assessments and interviews, and many candidates were shortlisted for the next rounds. The event served as a critical bridge between education and employment, giving students exposure to the demands of the professional world.

Faculty and representatives from the Sambhav Foundation worked in close coordination with college staff and volunteers to ensure smooth management of the entire process. The college also arranged support desks to assist students in drafting resumes and preparing for interviews. Career counseling sessions were conducted on-site to guide students on various career tracks suited to their qualifications and interests.

The job fair proved to be an excellent platform for networking, skill assessment, and employment generation. Many students expressed their appreciation for this real-world exposure, while employers commended the preparedness and enthusiasm of the candidates. The event ended on a positive and hopeful note, with several students receiving offer letters or being shortlisted for further recruitment processes.
