#### A short narration of the program

On 19th February 2025, St. Vincent College, Pune, observed Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Jayanti with a thoughtful and well-attended seminar titled "Contribution of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj in Shaping the Land of Maharashtra." The event was held in the college reading room, creating an intellectually engaging atmosphere conducive to reflection and learning. The seminar was organized to honor the legacy of the great Maratha ruler on his birth anniversary and to foster a deeper understanding of his enduring impact on Maharashtra's political, social, and cultural foundations.

The seminar was led by Dr. Anil Adsule, the Principal of the college, who served as the main resource person. Drawing from historical sources and scholarly analysis, Dr. Adsule presented a comprehensive overview of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj's visionary leadership and administrative acumen. He emphasized how Shivaji Maharaj was not merely a warrior king but a nation-builder who laid the early structures of self-rule (swarajya) based on justice, inclusivity, and good governance. Dr. Adsule highlighted key aspects of Shivaji Maharaj's contributions, including his innovative military strategies, establishment of a decentralized yet efficient administrative system, promotion of local languages in administration, and commitment to protecting the rights of peasants and women.

He also discussed the symbolic importance of forts in Shivaji Maharaj's strategy, illustrating how they served not only as defensive structures but as centers of governance and regional coordination. Dr. Adsule



underscored the ethical dimensions of Shivaji's leadership—his respect for all religions, treatment of prisoners of war, and emphasis on dharma as a guiding principle of rule. These values, he noted, remain relevant in contemporary discussions on leadership, integrity, and public service.

The interactive session that followed allowed students and faculty to engage with the topic more deeply, asking questions about Shivaji Maharaj's relationship with other contemporary powers, his naval initiatives, and the relevance of his ideals in modern governance. The reading room, surrounded by books and academic resources, provided a fitting backdrop for the discussion, reinforcing the connection between historical study and intellectual inquiry.

The seminar concluded with a note of appreciation for Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj not only as a historical figure but as a continuing source of inspiration for courage, justice, and ethical leadership. The event served as a meaningful academic tribute, encouraging participants to look beyond myth and legend to engage with the substantive contributions of one of Maharashtra's most transformative leaders.
