- A waste segregation process was implemented to dispose of unusable materials properly.

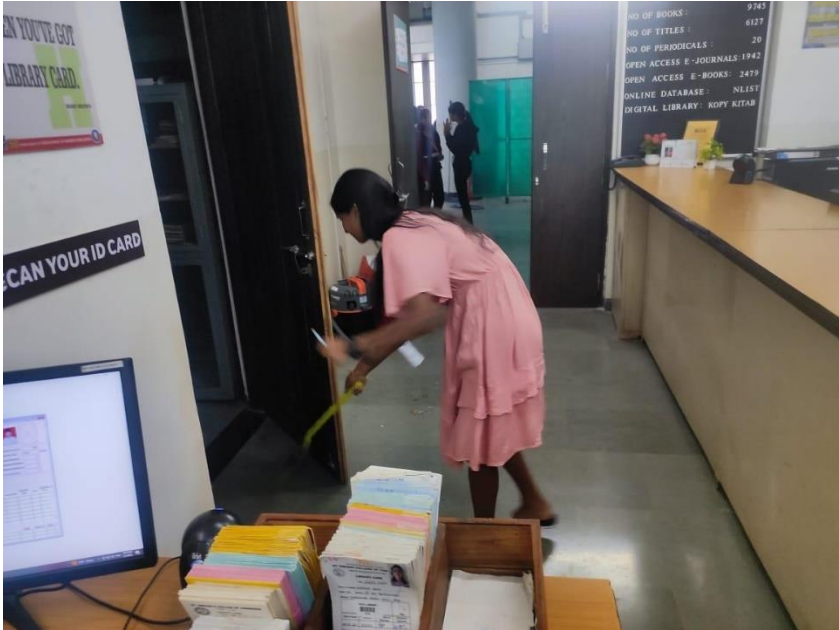
