This non-binding agreement establishes a structured framework for joint initiatives that foster civic responsibility, environmental stewardship, and community well-being.</p> <p>Under the MOU, St. Vincent College pledges institutional support to the ASEZ student chapter by facilitating access to campus facilities for organizing workshops, awareness forums, clean-up drives, tree plantation events, and educational seminars. The college also commits to promoting ASEZ’s core campaigns—including “Green Campus,” “Mother’s Street” cleanups, crime reduction through environmental beautification (guided by the Broken Windows Theory), and outreach to underprivileged communities.</p> <p>The agreement outlines clear channels for ongoing coordination between ASEZ representatives and the college administration, ensuring effective planning and execution of activities. It emphasizes mutual benefits: while ASEZ gains a committed academic partner to amplify its grassroots impact, St. Vincent College reinforces its identity as a socially responsible institution that nurtures ethically grounded, globally aware, and action-oriented youth leaders.</p>
