A short narration of the program

On 1st October 2024, the NSS department of St. Vincent College organized a Cleanliness Drive and Awareness Rally, commemorating Gandhi Jayanti and aligning with the spirit of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. The event aimed to foster a sense of social responsibility and civic awareness among students by encouraging them to actively participate in creating a cleaner and healthier environment.

Objectives of the Event

The primary objectives of the drive and rally were:

To promote cleanliness and hygiene within the campus and surrounding areas.

To spread awareness about the importance of sanitation and waste management among students and the local community.

To encourage students to take ownership of their environment and volunteer for social causes.

Inaugural Session and Flag-Off

Cleanliness Drive Activities

Volunteers collected litter, segregated waste into biodegradable and non-biodegradable categories, and disposed of it properly. They also cleaned notice boards and public areas within the campus to ensure a neat and organized environment.

The NSS department provided gloves, garbage bags, brooms, and other cleaning equipment to all volunteers. The drive helped in raising awareness about the importance of cleanliness as part of daily life.

Awareness Rally

Following the cleanliness drive, an awareness rally was conducted to spread the message of sanitation, waste management, and hygiene. The rally, led by NSS volunteers, proceeded through major streets surrounding the college.

Volunteers carried banners and posters with slogans like:

- “Clean India, Green India”
- “Swachhata hi Seva” (Cleanliness is Service)
- “Don’t Litter, Make Earth Better”

They also distributed flyers to passersby, urging them to adopt eco-friendly practices such as waste segregation and reducing plastic use. The rally was accompanied by chants promoting cleanliness, creating a positive and energetic atmosphere that engaged the local community. The event concluded with a vote of thanks by the NSS Program Officer, who appreciated the enthusiasm and dedication of the volunteers. He encouraged students to continue practicing cleanliness in their everyday lives and serve as role models in their communities. 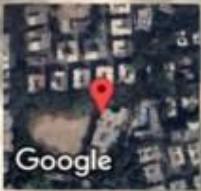
