Selection Interviews for Student Council and Committees

On July 29, 2025, St. Vincent College conducted a structured and transparent selection process for the Student Council and key student-led committees, including the All India Catholic University Federation (AICUF), Mother Teresa Vidyarthini Manch (MTVM), Media Team, and Event Management Committee. Held in the college seminar hall, the interviews were designed to identify students who demonstrate not only enthusiasm and talent but also a genuine commitment to service, responsibility, and the values that underpin each committee's mission.

The process was overseen by a faculty selection panel comprising experienced educators and coordinators familiar with the ethos and operational demands of each group. Candidates were evaluated through individual interviews that assessed a range of competencies, including clarity of expression, interpersonal awareness, problem-solving ability, initiative, and alignment with the specific vision of the committee they aspired to join. For instance, AICUF candidates were probed on their understanding of social action, MTVM applicants on empathy and gender-sensitive leadership, Media Team hopefuls on creativity and digital communication skills, and Event Management aspirants on organizational acumen and teamwork.

Rather than focusing solely on prior experience, the panel placed strong emphasis on potential, integrity, and willingness to learn—recognizing that leadership in a formative academic environment is as much about character as it is about capability. The atmosphere was professional yet supportive, reflecting the college's



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belief that student governance is a vital space for experiential learning in democracy, accountability, and collaborative decision-making.

The selection drive marks a critical milestone in shaping the student leadership architecture for the 2025–26 academic year. By entrusting students with meaningful roles in campus life—from organizing interfaith dialogues and social outreach to managing communications and coordinating college events—the institution reaffirms its commitment to participatory education and holistic development.

The outcomes of these interviews will enable the formation of a diverse, capable, and value-driven student leadership team, poised to contribute actively to the academic, cultural, and ethical fabric of St. Vincent College. This process not only identifies leaders but also cultivates a culture where responsibility, service, and student agency are integral to the collegiate experience.
